Description: Student Board Members will have an enriching experience helping to plan the 2018 Race for the Cure Eugene for Susan G. Komen Oregon and SW Washington. Bring your creativity, passion and talent to Susan G. Komen, Oregon and SW Washington. Komen is the leader in breast cancer research, early detection, survivor support, and advocacy for over 26 years. The board member will work as liaisons between Komen and the student body at their respective university. The board members will assist in the planning and executing campus registration and fundraising activities, fraternity and sorority engagement, and much more! Board Members will get the opportunity to work closely with Komen staff members, attend committee meetings in person, or via electronic conferencing once a month.

Candidate Requirements:

- Proficient computer skills, and capable in organizing Facebook and social media events.
- Friendly, outgoing, compassionate, and well connected in the campus community.
- Creative, thought generator, and team worker– we love new ideas!
- Passionate, and interested in making a difference in your community.

Responsibilities:

- Host 2 Race for the Cure registration events on campus.
- Support the Race by providing new ideas, and communicating information to the broader campus community.
- Attend monthly Race Committee meetings. In person is preferred, but by phone or video conference is acceptable.
- Help arrange for food, entertainment, and more at Race for the Cure.
- Design student campaign materials, including presentations, shirts, hand outs, posters, etc.
- Inspire students to build teams, and raise funds for program in the Eugene area.
- Assist with Race for the Cure material distribution throughout campus.
- Assist with volunteer recruitment for events and Race for the Cure weekend.
- Assist with Race for the Cure weekend events from Saturday, March 3 - Sunday, March 4 in Eugene, Oregon.

Qualifications:

- Must be enrolled at Oregon State University or University of Oregon, and interested in business, communications, human services, non-profits, leadership, public health, or a like field.
- Past fundraising, leadership, and/or event experience desired.
- Ability to lift up to 40 pounds.
- Ability to sit, stand, and work for extended periods of time at events as needed.
- Must be able to recruit volunteers to work registration events, and attend Race weekend and monthly meetings.

Time Frame and Commitment: Vary depending on the week and month

- December – January: about 3 hours a week
- February: 4 hours per week + host 2 registration events on campus
- March: 8 hours per day during Race weekend March 3 – 5, 2017. Assist with Race set up, registration, and engagement of students at the Race.
