However, because of it, she was given the honor of mentoring ladies that are on the same path she took 6 years ago.

Many of the Creekside Golf Club ladies are breast cancer survivors. During the event, Creekside WGA took a moment during the awards program to acknowledge all of the survivors that were playing golf or assisting in the event. It was a powerful moment!
